



Producer's Responsibility for VIN Entry on IZZY System

One of the most important data items required is the vehicle identification number. Not only is this an important rating component, but many states require that Insurance Companies report to them all vehicles that carry liability coverage. Accurate reporting of the vehicle identification number is critical for this reason.

IZZY Processing

Step 1: Always enter the entire 17 digit VIN and click Look up. If the VIN is not found, it could be that the vehicle is incomplete or was a special order vehicle with special features.

Step 2: If step 1 is unsuccessful, try to enter the Year, Make and Model and click Look up. If the vehicle is found; it backfills the vehicle features and you can view the detail information via the VIN Search Utility Screen. Also complete the actual complete VIN so all accurate digits are entered. The system will also ask you to select a symbol based on the cost of the vehicle when it was new.

Step 3: If step 1 and step 2 are unsuccessful, and the vehicle is newer than 1981, please contact your Underwriter to discuss. If the vehicle is incomplete, we will need to Underwrite upfront with photos of the vehicle and information regarding the use of the vehicle. If the vehicle is prior to 1981, you may manually enter the VIN.
